OUTDOOR RECYCLING CENTER

Have you ever heard the expression, "It takes one person to ruin it for the rest of us?" Well...that is exactly what happened a few weeks ago at our outdoor recycling center. Someone decided to leave the town a mess to clean up of 2 X 6 boards with nails, dresser drawers and a table. These items do not belong in the recycling center and since someone decided to use it as a dump site we had no other choice but to lock the recycling center. You can go to City Hall to get a key for the locked gates during business hours Monday – Friday 8:00 a.m. – 4 p.m. We know this is an inconvenience to many of our citizens as we get busy on the weekends trimming our trees and shrubs and needing a place to put our grass clippings. We do apologize for this, however, we had no choice but to keep this area locked to avoid further illegal dumping. This center only takes tree limbs up to 12 inches in diameter, shrub trimmings and grass clippings and leaves. **Please note – when the gates are locked this does not mean you can pile your outdoor waste outside the fenced area!** This recycling center is a good thing to our community and we hope people will use it for the reason it was built!
