NEW TOWN ORDINANCE

Town Ordinance No. 602 regulates the parking and use of recreational vehicles on residential property within the Town of Oakesdale. A summary as follows:

3.84.010 Definitions. “Recreational Vehicle” shall mean a vehicular-type unit primarily designed for recreational camping or travel use that has its own motive power or is mounted on or towed by another vehicle, including without limitation, travel trailers, fifth-wheel trailers, folding camp trailers, truck campers, and motor homes.

3.84.020 Parking. The outside parking of an unoccupied recreational vehicle is permitted on property with an established residential use, regardless of the zoning. Such parking shall be within the side, rear or front yard and shall not extend into the public right-of-way nor obstruct the clear vision area of the street.

3.84.030 Temporary use on residential property. A recreational vehicle may be used as a temporary accommodation to allow the owner to construct a permanent residence or remodel an existing residence. This shall be authorized by written approval from the Town Council. Temporary accommodation for guests may be allowed and shall not exceed 14 days. An extension for temporary accommodation may be allowed by the discretion of the Town Council especially for a medical hardship.

3.84.050 Penalty. Violation of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not more than \$250 for each violation.
