RULES OF CONDUCT AT CITY HALL

Our Council Members adopted Ordinance No. 613 establishing procedures for Rules of Conduct in the Town Hall:

1. Introduction:

The following rules apply to persons within the Town Hall, including, without limitation, the Clerk’s office, Council chambers, Marshal’s office, restroom facilities, and entry foyer to Town Hall. These rules do not provide for a criminal or civil penalty; any violations of State or local law shall be punishable separately. However, a person who violates these rules may be excluded from the Town Hall as provided in Oakesdale Municipal Code §3.38.020

2. Town Hall Rules of Conduct:

A. No person within the Town Hall shall commit a violation of any federal or State law, or any ordinance of the Town of Oakesdale or any section of the Oakesdale Municipal Code.

B. The following conduct is expressly prohibited within the Town Hall:

1. Any conduct that unreasonably interferes with use of the Town Hall by others, unreasonably interferes with the duties of public officials and public employees, or is otherwise unreasonably disruptive to the normal conduct of business within the Town Hall.
2. Bullying, harassing or aggressive behavior toward others, including, without limitation, obscene language or gestures and fighting.
3. Disrupting legitimate events and sponsored activities within the Town Hall, including, without limitation, Town Council meetings, Council committee meetings, public hearings, and similar gatherings.
4. Conduct that creates an unreasonable and substantial risk of harm to any person or property.
5. Defacing, destroying, damaging, or vandalizing Town Hall facilities.
6. Unlawful possession or use of drugs, alcohol, or firearms.

LAST MONTH TO BURN

June is the last month to burn your yard waste. You can still burn Monday – Saturday beginning at 7:30 a.m. and the fire must be fully extinguished by 4:00 p.m. – **NO SMOLDERING!** There will be a Town burning ban through July, August & September.
