DOG TAGS

Dog tags are required each year for all dogs within our city limit effective January 01, 2020. Fees for spayed or neutered dogs are \$7.50 each and \$10.00 for nonspayed or non-neutered dogs. All dogs must have rabies vaccination per WA State RCW codes. Dog tags must be purchased by January 31, 2020 to avoid a \$5.00 late fee per dog per month. Dog tag fees can not be included in your utility bill payment. Payments can be made by cash, check or money orders. You must have proof of rabies vaccination to license your dog(s) from your vet.
