SNOW REMOVAL

As we begin to see winter's presence, your Public Works Department is doing all they can to keep the streets plowed and sanded. We have one truck setup for plowing snow and sanding streets and we use a snow bucket on the front of the backhoe. When we get hit by a big snow storm, it can take most of a day to plow all the streets in town. Some of our streets are narrower than others and it does help if vehicles can be removed from the side of the streets or from city right-of-ways to allow our plows to clear a better path.

NEW WATER RATES FOR 2021

Effective January 1, 2021 the basic monthly water rate will be increased to \$44.80 for 4,125 gallons or 550 cubic feet depending on the type of water meter you have. This increase will show on the January 29, 2021 billing due by February 20, 2021.

TOWN LEVIES

We appreciate all the support our Town levies received during the General Elections! Prop#1 (Public Safety Levy) for fire protection and emergency medical services received 87.45% approval, Prop#2 (Street Levy) for street lights and maintaining our streets received 74.69% and Prop#3 (Street Levy) for crack sealing and chip sealing some of our streets received 68.85%. DOG LICENSES

Just a friendly reminder, that dog tags are due in January 2021. We must have your dog's rabies information to purchase a license. The cost is \$7.50 for spayed/neutered dogs and \$10 for non spayed/neutered dogs. You must pay the dog tag fees in a separate payment from your water/sewer bill. Thank you!
