NEW WATER RATES ON THE JAN. 29th BILL

The new base water rate of \$44.80 per month will show on your January 29, 2021 billing statement. Council members passed an Ordinance in August 2020 increasing the basic water rates by \$15 over the next 5 months beginning on September 1, 2020. Water rates were increased by \$7.50 in September 2020 and another \$7.50 on January 1, 2021. The base rate for your water/sewer bill with taxes is now \$85.99 a month. You receive 4,125 gallons or 550 cubic feet of water for the basic rate. If you should go over the allotted gallons or cubic feet, the cost remains the same at \$1.00 per 1,000 gallons. The late fee remains at \$25 for any unpaid balance on your account of \$10.01 or greater after the due date. There is a \$15.00 fee for any returned checks.

2021 DOG TAGS

Dog tags are required on all dogs residing in our city limits each year. The annual tags must be purchased by January 31, 2021 to avoid late fees and penalties. Dog tags that are purchased after the due date will incur a \$5 late fee making the dog tag cost \$12.50 for a spayed/neutered dog or \$15 if they are not spayed/neutered during the month of February. The late fees apply each month that the tag(s) are not purchased per dog. **REMEMBER...it is a state law and a Town Code that all dogs must be vaccinated for Rabies.** Before a tag can be issued, we must have the Rabies tag number, expiration and veterinary that issued the tag. <u>Please do not include the cost of your dog tag on your water bill. Payment for dog tags must be separate.</u>

LIBRARY NEWS

Due to the new COVID guidelines, libraries go back to curb side services only effective January 25th. February is Food for Fines Month. All Whitman County Libraries are accepting donations of non-perishable foods and toiletry items in exchange for up to \$10 in fines per account.
