WATER LEAK REPAIR

The water leak that occurred on Wednesday, May 11th at Henry St & HWY 27 had nothing to do with our water project or the contractor. We had a curb stop come detached from the water main causing a gusher. The shut off valve failed to work and it left us with no choice but to shut the water tower off to ease the pressure off the main so we could do the repair. In these emergency situations there is no way to warn our community except by word of mouth. Jake Dingman aided the Town by doing an emergency announcement through the schools' telephone system. All yard waste may be taken to the outdoor recycling center located off Bartlett Street behind the school's storage shed.
