SNOW REMOVAL

As we begin to see winter's presence, your Public Works Department will do all they can to keep the streets plowed and sanded. We have one truck setup for plowing snow and sanding streets and we use a snow bucket on the front of the backhoe. When we get hit by a big snow storm, it can take 10-12 hours to plow all the streets in town. Some of our streets are narrower than others and it does help if vehicles can be removed from the side of the streets or from city right-of-ways to allow our plows to clear a better path.

TRAILERS & RECREATIONAL VEHICLES

Town Code states trailers and recreational vehicles shall be parked on residential property within side, rear or front yards and shall not extend into the public right-of-way nor obstruct the clear vision area of the streets. **NO PUBLIC PARKING OF TRAILERS AND RECREATIONAL VEHICLES ON TOWN STREETS.** There has been several RVs parked along various streets around Town that will hinder the streets being plowed this winter. These RV's must be moved to their owner's private property.

DOG LICENSES

Just a friendly reminder, that dog tags are due in January 2023. We must have your dog's rabies information to purchase a license. The cost is \$7.50 for spayed/neutered dogs and \$10 for non spayed/neutered dogs. Dog tags must be purchased by January 31, 2023 to avoid late fees. You must pay the dog tag fees in a separate payment from your water/sewer bill. Thank you!
