BUILDING PERMITS

Do you plan on doing a home project this spring? Don't forget the building permit before you start! If you are planning on roofing or re-roofing an existing structure or siding or re-siding an existing structure or window replacement of an existing structure the permit fee is only \$40 no matter how much the project costs.

Due to many meter boxes being full of water, the meters were not read in March. You are still being billed for the minimum usage for March 2023. We will be reading meters in April around the 24th of the month. Your bill that will be due in May will have six months of water usage and you may or may not see an increase in your bill depending on the amount of water you used in that time period. The bill will reflect any overages that occurred in the past six months. If your bill should reflect an undetected water leak you may be able to petition the Town Council for an adjustment in the charges for the period during which the leak remained undetected.
