BUILDING PERMITS

Do you plan on doing a home project this spring? Don't forget the building permit before you start! If you are planning on roofing or re-roofing an existing structure or siding or re-siding an existing structure or window replacement of an existing structure the permit fee is only \$40 no matter how much the project costs.



WATER METERS

The water meters were read on March 25th and March 26th after the 5 months of winter. Your bill that will be due in April will have five months of water usage and you may or may not see an increase in your bill depending on the amount of water you used in that time. The bill will reflect any overages that occurred in the past five months. If your bill should reflect an undetected water leak you may be able to petition the Town Council for an adjustment in the charges for the period during which the leak remained undetected.

Whitman County will be having its annual Spring Clean- Up Week during **Friday, April 12th to Saturday, April 20th**. Rates are reduced to \$55.00 per ton with a \$15.00 minimum charge. Hello Spring! Remember the Town has a recycling center for grass, yard debris, flower bed and garden trimmings, shrubs, and branches. The center is located off the northside off Bartlett just off Highway 27 in the enclosed area behind the school's old storage building. This service is **FREE** for all our Town's residents. Your yard recyclables need to be dumped into the appropriate areas in the fence and no bins, bags or boxes left behind. What you bring your yard debris in needs to go home with you! **No processed wood allowed!** The only wood allowed is from your tree trimmings.
