### OAKESDALE CEMETERY

Please take note that due to high winds and potential mower damage, the cemetery will **NO longer** allow items such as flags, solar lights, planters, etc. to be placed off the headstone **onto the grass**. We can drill a hole in the pad of the headstone for a shepherd's hook for your items to hang. All items left at the headstone after June 10<sup>th</sup> will be collected and brought to the gazebo for collections.

### POOL NEWS

Oakesdale Park & Rec are planning opening day of the pool for FREE swim on the last day of school on Friday, June 7<sup>th</sup>. Single Season pass is \$60, Family of four pass is \$100, additional members \$20 each, and a daily pass in \$5. ### LAST MONTH TO BURN

June is the last month to burn your yard waste. You can still burn Monday – Saturday beginning at 7:30 a.m. and the fire must be fully extinguished by 4:00 p.m. – **NO SMOLDERING!** There will be a Town burning ban through July, August & September. All yard waste may be taken to the outdoor recycling center located off Bartlett Street behind the school's storage shed.

### YARD WASTE RECYCLING

The yard waste recycling center is open for citizens to take their yard debris all year round. You can bring grass clippings, shrub trimmings, tree branches, flowerbed material, and garden waste. Each area in the recycling center is marked for your disposals. This is a **free service** to our residents and we hope you continue to make use of it. **NO DUMPING OF PROCESSED WOOD! NO HAY OR STRAW BALES ALLOWED!**
